# **Integrated Co-Occurring Disorders Billing Guide**



Guidanace for coordinated care organizations and direct service providers

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## Introduction

Effective January 1, 2023, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will implement Oregon Health Plan (OHP) coverage of integrated treatment of co-occurring disorders (ICD).

- For services rendered to coordinated care organization (CCO) members, CCOs will reimburse eligible providers through a CCO Behavioral Health Directed Payment.
- OHA will reimburse providers for services rendered to fee-for-service members.

Both CCO and FFS coverage will provide a uniform payment increase to eligible providers.

#### **About the ICD Treatment Initiative**

OHA's ICD Treatment Initiative seeks to eliminate barriers to access and provide meaningful and responsive treatment for Oregonians dealing with Co-Occurring Disorders (COD). In addition to the restructuring of OHP fee-for-service and CCO payment methodologies, the initiative is working to:

- Guide and support organizational culture change.
- Support and expand the practice scope and skill set of treatment providers and peer service providers working in ICD settings.
- Develop and sustain a Statewide Integrated Co-Occurring Disorders Treatment Providers Community of Practice

For these reasons, OHA's approval process for ICD programs focuses on supporting ongoing participation in the culture of change and expansion of specialty scope of practice and skill sets.

## **About this guide**

This guide is outpatient behavioral health services providers to learn how to:

- Enroll as an Oregon Medicaid provider
- Apply for approval as an ICD program or ICD practitioner
- Bill for eligible services provided to OHP members.

### **Provider enrollment**

#### **Provider types**

Eligible providers are outpatient behavioral health service providers who:

- Are enrolled with OHA as an OHP (Oregon Medicaid) provider,
- Are approved by OHA to provide ICD services, and
- Employ staff qualified to render ICD services.

OHA has updated Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) <u>309-019-0145 effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023.</u> OHA is in process of updating <u>309-018-0160</u> with these requirements. OHA anticipates finalizing 309-018-0160 before June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023.

#### **Provider specialties**

In MMIS, only the following specialty types indicate approved ICD providers. Only these providers may bill for ICD services.

- **006:** ICD program
- **007:** Non-QMHP level practitioner
- **008:** QMHP level or above provider
- 009: ICD Problem Gambling Specialist

#### How to enroll with OHA

To enroll with OHA as an OHP provider, <u>visit the Provider Enrollment web page</u>. Click on the Provider Description that describes you (*e.g.*, Behavioral Health Outpatient Program) to find the required forms and documents.

### How to become an approved ICD treatment provider

The payment methodologies employed for ICD treatment in OAR 309-19-0145 and forthcoming OAR 309-018-0160 require provider organization approval by OHA. This approval is needed to ensure that provider organizations and practitioners are in alignment with intent and practice of ICD treatment and recovery services

and to ensure proper payment for these specialty services.

Individual practitioners approved by their organization to provide Integrated Co-Occurring Disorders services will need to register with OHA through their organization. Practitioners will need to have independent Medicaid Identification numbers for billing purposes.

OHA's Integrated Co-Occurring Disorders Program Staff will work with OHA's Certification & Licensing Unit to conduct program adherence reviews concurrently with routine site reviews.

#### **Provider organizations**

Provider organizations must apply for approval as an ICD treatment provider using the application on the ICD web page at <a href="Oregon.gov/ICD">Oregon.gov/ICD</a>.

OHA ICD staff will work with approved programs to obtain their lists of qualified service provider staff.

#### **Rendering providers (practitioners)**

Provider organizations will register their approved practitioners with OHA when they apply for ICD approval, and update their lists of approved providers quarterly with OHA. OHA will supply a form for these updates. Organizations must submit these reports must no later than 30 days from close of each calendar quarter. Practitioners must complete required trainings within 12 months of being named an ICD practitioner by their organization, as required by OAR 309-019-0145 and forthcoming amendment to OAR 309-018-0160.

#### **CCO** participation

OHA will provide CCOs lists of local certified organizations and their approved staff through the CCO's designated contract administrator contact.

- CCOs shall create contracts with approved provider organizations, as described in their contracts with OHA.
- CCOs should include provider reporting of approved service staff changes at regular intervals in their contracts and agreements with approved provider organizations.

## **Billing for Covered Services**

#### **Covered services**

For approved ICD providers, services eligible for ICD rate enhancements must:

- List two or more diagnoses from the approved ICD diagnoses list (see Appendix A).
- Use service codes from the approved ICD service codes list (see <u>Appendix B</u>).
- Be rendered by an approved ICD practitioner as described in OAR <u>309-019-0145</u> (outpatient) or OAR <u>309-018-0160</u> (residential).

#### **Modifiers**

All claims for ICD services must include either the HH or HO modifier.

- **HH:** Integrated Co-Occurring Disorders Program, services rendered by approved provider. Use for services rendered by providers with ICD specialty code 007 or 009.
- **HO:** Outpatient services rendered by approved provider with QMHP level or higher certification in a behavioral health field, qualified by OAR <u>309-019-0125</u>. Use for services rendered by providers with ICD specialty code 008 or 009.

Note: Some CCOs may use a different payment methodology. Please verify with your CCO how they will structure reimbursement.

## Eligibility and enrollment

Please verify OHP eligibility and enrollment prior to rendering service or billing. Go to the OHP Eligibility Verification page to learn more.

## Billing and coding

Refer to Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) or Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code descriptions and standards for more information.

Providers that are not dually credentialed will need to ensure that their billing aligns with their credential, provider type, service codes and primary diagnosis codes. Integrated Co-Occurring Disorders Practitioners continue to be required to provide and document services within the scope of practice of their credential. The ICD Specialty Endorsement permits the practitioner to bill for services rendered at enhanced rates due to their expanded practical knowledge as evidenced by the specialty endorsement.

#### To receive Integrated Co-Occurring Disorders enhanced payments for previously submitted claims:

For services provided on or after January 1st, 2023, providers can adjust eligible claims as follows:

For each eligible service on a paid detail line, add a second detail line including either the HH or HO modifier and adjust the claim.

## **Appendix A: Approved ICD Diagnoses**

#### **Approved diagnostic combinations**

Co-occurring disorders are defined through the experience and diagnoses of at least one addiction disorder (substance use disorder or gambling disorder) and at least one mental health disorder.

- Diagnostic combinations must contain at least one disorder from each behavioral health category.
- For individuals dealing with intellectual or developmental disabilities (I/DD), only one diagnostic category (either addiction or mental health) is required. I/DD and neurocognitive diagnostic codes are for informational purposes only. ICD programs are not qualified or required to diagnose or treat I/DD or neurocognitive disorders. Programs are required to appropriately adapt treatment for behavioral health disorders for people experiencing I/DD and neurocognitive disorders.

## **Appendix B: Approved ICD Service Codes**

Please refer to published fee schedules for updates to approved service codes for services to FFS members. For approved codes for services to CCO members, consult the member's CCO.

Eligible services may only be provided by OHA-approved ICD organizations rendered by OHA-approved ICD practitioners. Services must address two or more qualifying diagnoses as identified in assessments, service plans and service notes.
