

Integrated Co-Occurring Disorders Structured Technical Assistance Programs

The OHA-ICOD initiative is facilitating two structured technical assistance programs for provider organizations that have had their eligibility to provide Integrated Co-Occurring Disorders Treatment services validated by OHA-ICOD. OHA-ICOD will be working to develop specialty funding opportunities for participating organizations. To acquire and maintain eligibility for new funding opportunities, an eligible ICOD provider organization will meet the following minimum requirements:

- Eligibility validation in good standing and listed on the OHA-ICOD webpage as an approved program.
- Programs with initial eligibility validation of less than two years; program will have completed – or be in the process of completing – the OHA-ICOD Structured Development Program (see below).
- Programs with initial eligibility validation of two years or more; program will have completed the OHA-ICOD Structured Fidelity Review Program (see below).

Structured Development Program

OHA-ICOD will facilitate a structured program development process for newly validated programs. The program will consist of:

- Initial Program Self Evaluation
- Collaborative Evaluation Review with OHA-ICOD Staff
- Development of implementation plan in collaboration with OHA-ICOD Staff
- Four quarterly follow up meetings to review challenges and successes with implementation plan.

Structured Fidelity Review Program

OHA-ICOD will facilitate a structured, collaborative Fidelity Review meeting with the program. The meeting will be based on results from the program's self-evaluation using the IDDT Fidelity Scale and the OHA-ICOD Supplemental Fidelity Scale. The OHA-ICOD team will provide consultation for program development based on the results of the self-assessment.
