General Guidance for All Potential Applicants:

We have received questions about whether we can fund a project with a specific scenario. Please note we can't answer these questions because they effectively are asking if we can make a tentative commitment to fund such a project. Our advice is following the criteria in the Application Notice to your best ability and present the scenario in your application.

The RFGA posted to the OHA SDOH webpage on August 8, 2022 has an Addendum posted on September 19, 2022 that reflects the changes regarding submitting the Letter(s) of Endorsement.

Questions + Answers

Housing Type and Population

Q: Is this funding part of the \$130 million dollars for behavioral housing?

A: No, this not part of the \$130 million for behavioral housing.

Q: If we start from scratch, do we need to be licensed first to be eligible for the grant application?

A: No, you do not need to be licensed to apply for the grant application, however you must be licensed to provide services before doors open.

Q: Are CBO/nonprofits eligible to apply?

A: Yes, CBO/nonprofits are eligible to apply.

Q: When is the RFGA due?

A: The RFGA is due by October 1,2022 at 11:59 pm.
