If you disagree with OHA's funding decision, please contact Housing Development Coordinator. If this doesn't resolve the issue, you may request an appeal as described in Section 13 of the RFGA.

- The designee for receiving appeal requests is Chelsea Holcomb. Submit requests by January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- OHA will notify you in writing of the decision to approve or deny the appeal within 15 days of receiving the appeal.
