Guidance Document

Bridging the Diagnostic Classification of Mental Health and Developmental Disorders of Infancy and Early Childhood (DC:0-5), the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, Fifth Edition (DSM 5), and the International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems, tenth revision (ICD 10) to aid behavioral health providers with developmentally appropriate diagnoses.

It is important to note that Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) coverage in Oregon expanded January 1, 2023. OHA and CCOs must cover all medically necessary and medically appropriate services for OHP members under age 21, regardless of placement on the Prioritized List of Health Services. Medical necessity and medical appropriateness are determined on a case-by-case basis, taking into account the member's needs.
