Subject: Optional Metrics Update

OHA is amending previous requirement for CCBHC to report on certain options metrics. OHA will be dropping the requirement to report on the following:

- 1) Child and Adolescent Major Depressive Disorder (MDD): Suicide Risk Assessment (SRA-C)
- 2) Adult Major Depressive Disorder (MDD): Suicide Risk Assessment (SRA-A)
- 3) Controlling High Blood Pressure (CBP-AD)

Why is this happening?

SAMHSA updated federal criteria requiring states to identify required metrics from a list of optional metrics provided. After receiving additional feedback and doing addition review of the metrics, OHA has decided to drop these metrics to alleviate administrative burden and to allow clinics the flexibility to align practices more closely with existing requirements and processes around these measures.

What should you do?

CCBHCs no longer have to report on these metrics effective 4/1/24.
