Mobile Health Unit Pilot Program Update

HB 4052 (2022) directs OHA to study the feasibility of expanding mobile health units across Oregon. An interim report is due to the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2025, and a final report no later than June 30, 2026.

OHA and the Contracts Office conducted an Intermediate Solicitation process to seek organizations to develop an evaluation plan as part of the larger feasibility study of the Mobile Health Unit Pilot Program.

Following the Intermediate Solicitation process, OHA is excited to announce The Rede Group has been awarded funds to a contract to develop an evaluation plan and assess current mobile health capacities within the state.

The Rede Group is an Oregon-based consultancy focusing on health equity. As a social impact company, Rede works with Tribal, state, and local governments and non-profit organizations to design and implement program and process evaluations. Rede's primary aim is to bring clarity and engagement to evaluation planning.

What's Next?

OHA will meet with each Grantee in August to partner and support Program onboarding. Program start dates vary across each Grantee, with project timelines ranging from 12 to 18 months of service delivery from start date.

The Rede Group will work collaboratively to implement the Mobile Health Unit Pilot Program and develop a plan to measure its overall effectiveness.
