



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Zoom meeting tip: Asking questions

Oregon Health Plan (OHP) - Benefit Update Project (BUP) Most Important Take-Aways

- A project to update the organization of OHP benefits so that all medically necessary services within the scope of OHP are covered.
- This change is mostly administrative rather than a change to how OHP services are delivered.
- No members will lose services as a result of this transition.
- Some services not covered today will be added to the benefit package.



As of January 1, 2027



OHP Benefit Organization

- Since 1994 Oregon has used the Prioritized List of Health Services as the basis for most OHP coverage decisions.
- Health Evidence Review Commission (HERC) provides evidence-based reviews of services and ranks them on the List
- Legislature sets a funding line services above the funding line are funded and those below the funding line are not covered.



2012 – 2026: OHP Benefit Organization

Prioritized List:

- No longer serving as a budgeting tool
- Oregon's funding line hasn't moved up since 2012
- 97% of Oregonians have health coverage now
- Doesn't cover some Mandatory services (per federal guidelines)
- 2026- Special waiver from federal rules, that allows Oregon to use Prioritized List, expires on 12/31/2026.

This transition provides us with an opportunity to realign our benefit package with the federal requirements.

Starting 2027 January – OHP benefit organization

- Transition away from Prioritized List (Benefit Update Project, BUP)
 - Transition to service groups within Mandatory and Optional categories

Mandatory services – services states are required to cover per federal guidelines.

Optional services - services states can choose to cover

- Some services currently below the funding line to be newly covered
- New appeals process for Open Card members
 - Note: CCO members already have an established appeals process






OHP Benefits current state and future state

Continuing 2027 January: OHP Covered Benefits

- Oral Health benefits (<u>Optional benefits</u>):
 - No anticipated changes as a result of this project.
 - Current limitations, such as those on crowns or root canals, etc. outside EPSDT and YSHCN population and beyond what is currently addressed in the <u>dental rule</u> will remain in place

Starting 2027 January: OHP Newly Covered Benefits (1/2)

- Behavioral Health benefits (<u>Optional benefits</u>):
 - Small expansion including coverage of psychotherapy services for some additional diagnoses, such as somatization disorder, somatoform disorders and chronic pain disorders for which psychotherapy is considered medically necessary

Starting 2027 January: OHP Newly Covered Benefits (2/2)

- Physical Health or medical/surgical benefits (both <u>Mandatory and</u> <u>Optional services</u>):
 - Some medically necessary services will be added.
 - The HERC workplan contains a list of services that are being reviewed and may be included in the OHP benefit: https://www.oregon.gov/oha/HPA/DSI-HERC/Pages//BUP-Workplan.aspx
 - The Pharmacy & Therapeutics (P&T) Committee has produced a similar workplan for medications that may be added or updated (coming soon)

Starting Jan 2027: What will change

- Some new services will be added
- Denials for services will be based on lack of medical necessity (no denials based on a service position below-the-line)

Continuing Jan 2027: What will not change

- HERC will continue to do its jobs:
 - Provide evidence-based reviews resulting in:
 - Code pairing files
 - Guideline notes
 - Statements of intent
 - Maintain its decision-making role
 - HERC committee, subcommittees and public processes will continue
- Basis for benefit determination:
 - Medical Necessity (policy defined by individual states)
 - Program Rules: Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR)
 - Other OHA policies
- Some medically necessary services will remain outside the OHP benefit.




Survey: Which topics do you want more education on?
