ASAM ENHANCED SERVICE DESIGATIONS:

- Which programs are required to be certified for these designations?
 - Providers who are currently approved to render Integrated Cooccurring Disorders (ICD) in accordance with OAR 309-019-0145, must also be certified to render ASAM Co-occurring Capable or Enhanced Services applicable to the ASAM Level(s) of Care selected in the ASAM Level of Care application.
 - However, SUD programs that are not approved to render Integrated Co-occurring Disorders (ICD) in accordance with OAR 309-019-0145, are not required to be certified to render ASAM Co-occurring Capable or Enhanced Services.



ASAM ENHANCED SERVICE DESIGATIONS:

- > ASAM Level of Care 1:
 - Co-occurring Capable
 - Co-Occurring Enhanced must also be ICD Approved per OAR 309-019-0182 (7) (b) (A)
- > ASAM Level of Care 2.1:
 - Co-occurring Capable must also be ICD Approved per OAR 309-019-0183 (7) (a)
 - Co-Occurring Enhanced must also be ICD Approved per OAR 309-019-0183 (7) (b) (A)
- > ASAM Level of Care 2.5:
 - Co-occurring Capable must also be ICD Approved perOAR 309-019-0184 (8) (b)
 - Co-Occurring Enhanced must also be ICD Approved OAR 309-019-0184 (10) (a)

ASAM APPROVAL TIMELINE

- ASAM LEVEL OF CARE APPLICATIONS: per OAR -
 - Emailed to providers on May 30, 2023
 - ➢ Due October 1, 2023.
 - The existing certificate and/ or license(s) will be updated to include all approved ASAM Levels of Care from January 1, 2024 through March 31, 2024.
 - ➢ ASAM COMPLIANCE REVIEWS: begin April 1, 2024
- > This applies to all SUD programs, regardless of payer mix.
- All SUD programs will submit ASAM Level of Care applications for each applicable service: OP, RES and/ or WM.



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TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE



- ASAM books were sent to all SUD providers. These books assist the program in completing selfassessments and building policy, procedure and forms that will be compliant with the new ASAM rules.
- 6 ASAM Implementation Workgroups are offered monthly to a variety of provider types.
- Workgroup Topics include: ASAM OARs, ASAM Level of Care Applications, ASAM assessments and service plans, etc.
- Some providers are working together to create assessment templates or policy and procedures.



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NEXT STEPS

- The Implementation Workgroups will continue into 2024 to assist programs in making any needed changes to demonstrate compliance with the new rules.
- ASAM trainings and integration of The ASAM CONTINUUM software will be available once contracting is complete.
- Compliance tools are being developed that HSD staff will use for renewal reviews. These will be shared with providers.
- OHA will begin compliance reviews for the ASAM OARs on April 1, 2024.
- OHA will address any needed changes to OAR in response to the publication of *The ASAM Criteria*, *Fourth Ed*.
- HSD staff forward inquires regarding rate differentials to leadership.
