Subject: Quarterly submission of Notices of Adverse Benefit Determination

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision to waive the following requirement in the Contract Year (CY) [2024](#) CCO contract:

- [Exhibit I, Section 10, Paragraph b, Subparagraph \(4\)](#): This subparagraph describes the requirement for the CCO to submit all Notices of Adverse Benefit Determination (NOABDs) for Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) and Hepatitis C on a quarterly basis. These NOABDs are due 45 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

OHA hereby waives the requirement to submit the NOABDs for ABA and Hepatitis C for the remaining reporting quarter in CY 2024 (Oct-Dec2024). This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirements relating to the Grievance and Appeal System in the CY 2024 contract.

This quarterly NOABD submission requirement has been eliminated for CY [2025](#).
