Notice of intent – OHA will amend the Medicaid State Plan and the Alternate Benefit Plan (ABP) to remove Prepaid Ambulatory Health Plan (PAHP) as a type of Managed Care Organization (MCO) risk contract

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is amending Oregon's Medicaid State Plan and Alternate Benefit Plan to remove PAHP as a type of MCO risk contract.

Background

Dental care organizations (DCO) are the only type of PAHP entity that currently serves Oregon Health Plan (OHP) members. Starting January 1, 2023, OHA will no longer contract with DCOs. Instead, coordinated care organizations (CCOs) will deliver dental services through their existing networks. [More information about this change is available on the OHP website.](#)

EPSDT and tribal consultation

These amendments will not change any coverage or benefits or how OHP provides Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) services. OHA has followed the tribal consultation process established under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and as set forth in its approved state plan.
