Subject: APCM Updates (NeCR Pilot and APCM Quality Metrics Report)

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) plans to pilot the Non-Engaged Patient Closure Report (NeCR) Oct. 1, 2026, through Sept. 30, 2027: If you report any non-engaged patients during the pilot:

- Per-Member-Per-Month (PMPM) payments will not change.
- OHA will not disenroll patients. MMIS and CareSTEPS Database are independent of each other, so automatic updates from CareSTEPS to MMIS cannot occur.

Next steps

To prepare for the October 1 launch date, OHA is working to update the CareSTEPS Database and ensure site access for pilot participants.

OHA will also share a process document with pilot participants before the launch date. This will include:

- Main contacts for communication and data protection,

- How to provide feedback and
- How to navigate the database.

The APCM Quality Metrics Report will remain report-only through the current Participation Agreement (Jan. 1, 2026, through Dec.31, 2027).

What should you do?

At this time there is no additional action required from APCM participating in health centers and clinics.
