

Reminder of Annual Affiliated Medicare Advantage Plan Report

- The annual Affiliated Medicare Advantage (MA) Plan Report is due **by November 18, 2021**. This report outlines the CCO's affiliations or contracts with MA Plans and/or Dual Special Needs Plans (DSNPs) for CY 2022.
 - The above due date is an extension of the November 15th due date in the CCO contract, to provide for 90 days from when OHA provided the report template to CCOs..
- This year's reporting form has been updated from last year; the information requested is substantially similar. The form is posted on the CCO Contract Forms [webpage](#).
- Please work with your CCO's affiliated MA Plans and/or DSNPs to complete the report. The completed report must be signed and submitted by the CCO to the CCO deliverables email box: CCO.MCOCDeliverableReports@dhsoha.state.or.us
- The CCO must also provide OHA with a copy of the CY 2022 affiliation agreement or contract for each of its MA Plans **by December 2, 2021**. This is an extension of the November 15 deadline. These must be submitted to the CCO deliverables email box.
 - An exception to the above requirement is if the CCO's affiliated or contracted MA Plan is a same-parent company CCO-DSNP that already has a DSNP contract on file with OHA for CY 2022.

Upcoming Deadline to Notify OHA about Interest in 2023 DSNP Coordination of Benefits Agreement

- Any CCO that needs to request an MA Coordination of Benefits Agreement (COBA) for a DSNP with which it will contract for CY 2022 must submit its initial request to Jennifer Valentine, OHA's DSNP contracts coordinator, **no later than December 10, 2021**.
- Contracting for CY 2023 DSNPs begins in spring 2022. COBAs must be fully executed by late June 2022 to ensure CCOs can upload their contracts to CMS by the July 1, 2022, federal deadline.
- MA Plans that are not currently DSNPs should review the CMS announcement of changes in federal rule that begin limiting MA Plans as DSNP look-alikes in 2023 when serving Medicaid Dual Eligible populations. These changes were discussed in a webinar with CMS and the Integrated Care Resource Center in October 2019. Refer to the CMS [memo](#) dated June 8, 2020, for details.
