Subject: Fee-for-service rate increase for Medicaid behavioral health services, effective July 1, 2024

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is updating its fee-for-service claim system to reflect new reimbursement rates effective July 1, 2024. The increase:

- Applies to behavioral health services rendered on or after July 1, 2024.
- Applies 3.4 percent for rates listed in the <u>Behavioral Health Fee Schedule</u>.

OHA aims to have the 3.4 percent increase completed by the end of this month. When this work is complete, OHA will:

- Post communications on the <u>Behavioral Health Rate Increase page</u>.
- Post the new rates in the July 2024 Behavioral Health Fee Schedule.
- Adjust rates for adult mental health residential billing codes T1020 and T2033.

Why is this happening?

The 2022 Oregon Legislature granted OHA funding to increase behavioral health reimbursement and support improvements to Oregon's behavioral health system. This included funding an annual cost-of-living adjustment of 3.4 percent for State Fiscal Years 2023 and 2024.

What should you do once the rate updates are complete?

Adult mental health residential providers: Starting July 1, 2024, submit all claims at the higher rate as noted on each resident's plan of care.

Other behavioral health providers: Bill new claims at the higher amount listed in July 2024 Behavioral Health Fee Schedule.
