Subject: COVID Relief Temporary Rate Increase for State Fiscal Year 2021

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) has applied a temporary 10% rate increase to fee-for-service claims submitted by Oregon Medicaid mental health and substance use disorder residential providers serving adults or children. The rate increase applies to the following procedure codes, for dates of service from 7/1/2020 through 6/30/2021:

OHA is issuing the reimbursement for the 10% rate increase in two ways:

- For claims submitted from 7/1/2020 through 5/16/2021, OHA issued a lump sum payment on June 30, 2021. The summary page of the June 30 remittance advice from OHA lists the payment as a “system payout (non-claim specific)” with the reason code “8990.”
- The increased rate automatically applies to claims submitted on or after 5/17/2021.

Why is this happening?

The Oregon Legislative Emergency Board awarded funding for this rate increase in a [January 2021 certificate](#) to reimburse behavioral health residential providers for costs incurred due to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.

What should you do?

There is nothing you need to do. The automatic and lump sum payments reflect the rate increase for the residential services you provided for dates of service from 7/1/2020 through 6/30/2021.
