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Subject: Billing for services to Oregon Health Plan (OHP) residents

Effective July 1, 2018, AFH, RTF, RTH and SRTF providers may only bill OHP residents for room and board at the current Supplemental Security Income (SSI) rate of \$583 per month.

Providers may no longer bill OHP residents for any services covered under procedure codes T1020 or S5141 in an approved plan of care. To find a resident's current plan of care, use the Plan of Care search in the Provider Web Portal at <https://www.or-medicaid.gov>.

Why is this happening?

Federal Medicaid rules do not allow providers to collect more than the SSI room and board rate from these residents.

What should you do?

For services provided on and after July 1, 2018, please be sure to:

- Only bill OHP residents for room and board at the current SSI rate.
- Refund payments exceeding \$583 per month to OHP residents.
- Bill OHA for the full cost of personal care (T1020) and habilitation (S5141) services.
