Subject: Care Coordination activities report

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision to waive the following requirement in the Contract Year (CY) 2021 coordinated care organization (CCO) contracts:

- Exhibit B, Part 4, Section 7: Paragraph h. describes the requirement for the CCO to report on its Care Coordination activities as required by OAR [410-141-3860](#) and to submit the report to OHA according to the schedule specified in the rule. OHA filed a [temporary rule](#) effective February 10, 2021, that clarified the CY 2021 reporting periods and due dates for this report. The rule was [amended effective 7/1/2021](#) to further adjust the due dates. As a result of these rule changes, for CY 2021, the CCO is required to submit reports for April-June 2021 (Q2CY2021) and July-September 2021 (Q3CY2021) within 60 days from the end of each quarter.

OHA hereby waives the requirement to submit the Care Coordination activities report for Q3CY2021 as set forth in contract and rule as cited above. This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirement relating to Care Coordination described in the CCO contract and applicable rules.
