Subject: Change to care coordination activities report due 3/1/2024

This communication is about the following deliverable in the CY 2023 CCO contract:

- Exhibit B, Part 4, Section 7, Paragraph h: Care coordination activities report for July-December 2023 as required by OAR 410-141-3860. The report is due 3/1/2024.
 - *Note:* The above rule was revised effective 2/1/2024. The [previous version](#) of the rule applies due to the reporting period for the deliverable.

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will **defer enforcement of the requirement to submit the care coordination activities report for July-December 2023**. This means that CCOs are not required to submit the report at this time.

In the near future, OHA will invite CCOs to participate in the care coordination workgroup that will be re-launched in March. OHA is currently developing a model risk stratification methodology that will be distributed via this workgroup. OHA strongly encourages CCOs to participate in the finalization of the model methodology through the workgroup. Each CCO will have 90 days from when the final model is released to submit its risk stratification to OHA for approval.
