Subject: Changes to CY 2025 Attestation of compliance with “QDPs within CCO Payment Rates” requirements

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority’s (OHA) decision affecting the following requirement in the Contract Year (CY) [2025](#) coordinated care organization (CCO) contracts:

- Exhibit C, Section 1, Paragraph d, Subparagraph (1), Sub-Subparagraph (k): This contract provision describes the requirement for the CCO to submit an Attestation of compliance with the “Qualified Directed Payments (QDPs) within CCO Payment Rates” requirements. The initial Attestation is due by March 31, 2025. The updated Attestation is due by September 30, 2025, for any new Provider contracts or Provider contracts updated since the initial Attestation.

In the [memo](#) dated March 18, 2025, OHA notified CCOs that the due date for the initial Attestation was changed to “TBD” while OHA was awaiting federal approval of the dental directed payments. OHA received this federal approval last month.

OHA has decided to consolidate the two 2025 Attestations into a single Attestation due by September 30, 2025. OHA will consider this submission to be the initial Attestation. **OHA hereby waives the requirement to submit an *updated* Attestation.** This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirements relating to QDPs.
