Subject: Clarification on DHS-mandated COVID-19 testing in long-term care facilities

The Department of Human Services (DHS) has amended the definition of "Associated Staff" in <u>Oregon Administrative Rule 411-060-0005</u>, who are subject to the <u>DHS COVID-19 testing requirements for licensed assisted living facilities</u>, nursing facilities and residential care facilities.

- The amended rule now defines "associated staff" as staff providing direct care, environmental or food services to residents via a contractual relationship with the facility, effective August 10, 2020.
- This change means that home health and hospice staff who do not have, or whose employer does not have, a contractual relationship with the facility are no longer subject to the DHS COVID-19 testing requirements.

Why is this happening?

DHS made this change due to questions received from direct service providers about the COVID-19 testing requirements in Oregon's Long-Term Care Facility Testing Plan.

What should you do?

To learn more about this change, <u>please read the notice from DHS</u>. A copy of this notice is also attached.

Please also be sure to follow current state and federal guidance regarding infection control to protect the vulnerable populations we serve. RE: Long Term Care Facility Testing Rule

Oregon Administrative Rule 411-060

Dear Providers:

On August 10th, we amended the emergency rule related to testing in nursing facilities, residential care facilities and assisted living facilities. In summary, the changes are as follows:

- Modified the definition of "Associated Staff" to only include individuals providing direct care, environmental services and food services via a contractual relationship with the facility.
- Removed all references to prior authorization of testing providers.
- Clarified that private rooms/quarantining should be used for new admissions to the extent the facility's capacity/census permits private rooms to be used.
