Subject: Cooperative Agreements Reports

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision to waive the following requirements in the Contract Year (CY) 2021 coordinated care organization (CCO) contracts:

- Exhibit G, Section 3, Cooperative Agreements with Publicly Funded Programs Report: This section describes the requirement for the CCO to submit an annual report about its relationships with publicly funded programs. The report is due by July 1 of each Contract Year.
- Exhibit G, Section 4, Cooperative Agreements with Community Social and Support Service and Long Term Care Report: This section describes the requirement for the CCO to submit an annual report about its relationships with Community social and support service organizations and long term care organizations. The report is due by July 1 of each Contract Year.

OHA hereby waives the requirement to submit the annual Cooperative Agreements with Publicly Funded Programs Report and the annual Cooperative Agreements with Community Social and Support Service and Long Term Care Report as set forth in the contract sections cited above for CY 2021. This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirements relating to publicly funded programs, Community social and support service organizations, and long term care organizations.

OHA reserves the right to request the information that would have been provided in the waived reports. If this right is exercised, OHA will make its best efforts to provide CCOs with a reasonable timeframe to provide such information.
