Subject: Fee-for-Service (FFS) Dental Incentive Program ends September 30, 2020

Effective September 30, 2020, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is discontinuing the “Incentive” for Oral Health Prevention Fee-for-Service Program and repealing its supporting Oregon Administrative Rule, 410-123-1245.

Why is this happening?

This pilot program ran from January 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020. Unfortunately, OHA does not have the financial resources to continue the program. OHA also found that the existing incentives did not meet the program’s goals to increase FFS dental provider enrollment, access and provision of preventive dental services to Oregon Health Plan members.

OHA appreciates your participation and support of this program.

What should you do?

No action is required on your part. The last round of supplemental payments will be made in October 2020 to allow for claims lag and the close out of the program.
