Subject: Submitting fee-for-service claims to receive the July 1, 2022 birth doula rate increase

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) has updated its fee-for-service claim system to reflect the new Birth Doula rate increase effective July 1, 2022:

Code(s)	Description	Rate effective 7/1/2022
59400, 59510, 59610, 59610, 59618	Standard doula benefit with support at delivery	\$1,500.00
59899	Support visit (up to two prenatal and two postpartum visits)	\$215.00
59409, 59514, 59612, 59620	Partial doula services day of delivery only	\$645.00

The U9 modifier is still required for claims to process.

Why is this happening?

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services approved the rate increase November 4, 2022.

What should you do?

To receive the rate increase for services provided on or after July 1, 2022:

- Submit any unbilled claims for reimbursement.
- Adjust previously submitted claims. To do this, log into the MMIS Provider Portal at https://www.or-medicaid.gov and search for the claim by ICN. When adjusting the claim, change the billed amount on each detail line to the new rate, and then click the adjust button.
