Subject: Rate increases for family planning visits and vasectomies effective July 1, 2026.

Effective July 1, 2026, Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is increasing the fee-for-service rates for two family planning-related codes:

- The rate for HCPCS code T1015 (Clinic visit/encounter, all-inclusive; family planning) will increase from \$185 to \$230. Use of this code is limited to enrolled family planning clinics as outlined in [Oregon Administrative Rule 410-130-0587](#).
- The rate for CPT code 55250 (Vasectomy, removal of sperm duct(s)) will increase to \$500 for both the facility and non-facility rate.

Why is this happening?

Clinical providers, advocacy organizations, legislators and other partners have emphasized the need to pay higher rates for family planning services. To respond to this need, OHA conducted a 2025 assessment of current rates in Oregon and other states, and sought feedback from interested parties. These rate increases seek to improve the financial sustainability of providers and ensure ongoing access to essential family planning services for OHP members.

What should you do?

For family planning visits and vasectomies completed on or after July 1, 2026:

- **Providers:** Bill OHA at the increased rates.
- **CCOs:** Review your claims processing systems and contracts and make any necessary changes.
