Subject: Fee-for-service billing guidance for OHP-covered falls prevention programs, effective April 1, 2026

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) has published [new billing guidance for covered falls prevention programs](#). For each program, the guidance contains detailed information about:

- Eligible services,
- Billing requirements,
- Covered procedure codes and modifiers, and
- Fee-for-service reimbursement rates.

This guidance is effective for services provided on or after April 1, 2026.

Why is this happening?

According to [Guideline Note 106 of the Prioritized List of Health Services](#), OHP covers services provided through evidence-based falls prevention programs for any OHP member 65 and older, and anyone younger than 65 with identified falls risk. The new guidance explains how covered programs must operate and bill OHA to

maintain fidelity to the evidence-based requirements of their specific program.

What should you do?

For members receiving FFS (open card) coverage, [please refer to OHA's billing guidance](#) for services provided on or after April 1, 2026.

For members enrolled in a coordinated care organization (CCO), contact the member's CCO directly for information about coverage, billing requirements, and reimbursement rates. CCOs may establish their own billing policies and payment arrangements for falls prevention services.
