Notice of intent – OHA will amend the Medicaid State Plan to reflect a medical component and bundled rates for services provided under the Newborn Nurse Home Visiting Program effective January 1, 2022.

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will submit a State Plan Amendment to update Oregon's Medicaid State Plan to reimburse home visits provided through [Family Connects](#), Oregon's Universal Newborn Nurse Home Visiting program, under a statewide bundled rate as follows:

- 99502 with modifier 32 = \$592.81
- 99502 with modifiers 32 TD = \$242.31
- 99502 with modifiers 32 TT = \$170.65

This addition is expected increase annual aggregate Medicaid expenditures by \$3.3 million for the 2021-23 biennium.

Background:

The Universal Newborn Nurse Home Visiting Program provides home visits to eligible mothers, and infants from 0 through 6 months of age, as described in [Oregon Administrative Rule 333-006-0120](#). Services include maternal and newborn physical assessment and anticipatory and supportive guidance.
