Notice of intent – OHA will amend the Medicaid State Plan to increase fee-for-service rates for family planning services.

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) to increase fee-for-service rates as follows, effective July 1, 2026:

- Increase the bundled rate for family planning code T1015 to \$230.
- Pay for CPT procedure code 55250 (vasectomy) at a flat rate of \$500. OHA currently reimburses for this code based on Relative Value Unit weights and conversion factor.

The Total Fund annual estimated cost for this change is \$80,094.

Except as otherwise noted in the plan, state-developed fee schedule rates are the same for both governmental and private providers for #4.c through #4.d below. Oregon conversion factors as listed on Attachment 4.19-B, page 1 of this state plan. Unless noted otherwise the agency fee schedule was set for services on or after 7/1/26. 4.c. Family planning services and supplies:

Reimbursement for Family Planning services is provided in accordance with the same reimbursement provisions developed for specific practitioner types described in items 5.a Physicians, 3. Laboratory, 6.d Other practitioners' services, in attachment 4.19-B of this state plan. Except for Vasectomy code 52250 will be a flat rate of \$500.00 instead of the physicians RVU multiplied by Oregon specific conversion factor.

9. Clinic Services: Family Planning Clinic

Family Planning Clinics receive an all-inclusive encounter where the primary purpose of the visit is contraceptive in nature. The encounter code includes: Annual family planning exams; Family planning counseling; Insertions and removals of implants and IUDs; Diaphragm fittings; Dispensing of contraceptive supplies and contraceptive medications; Contraceptive injections; educational materials.

Reimbursement:

All-inclusive encounter code T1015= \$230.00
Vasectomy code 55250= flat rate of \$500.00

Services outside of the encounter code T1015:

Contraceptive supplies, contraceptive medications and laboratory. Reimbursement for these are in accordance with the same reimbursement provisions developed for specific practitioner types described in item 4.c. Family planning services and supplies :

Limitations:

One encounter per date of service;
Educational materials are not billable separately from T1015.
