Subject: Fee-for-service SUD rate increases effective February 1, 2018

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is making the following changes to the [Oregon Health Plan \(OHP\) fee-for-service fee schedule](#). These rates apply only to claims billed to OHA by enrolled and participating OHP providers for members not enrolled in a CCO.

| Treatment code | Modifier | Current rate | New rate effective February 1, 2018 |
|----------------|----------|--------------|-------------------------------------|
| 90849 | HF or HG | \$37.38 | \$45.09 |
| 90887 | HF or HG | \$33.23 | \$90.14 |
| H0004 | HF or HG | \$17.46 | \$22.47 |
| H2016 | HF | \$86.23 | \$200.58 |
| T1013 | HF | \$7.69 | \$8.16 |

Why is this happening?

OHA found that the rate paid to SUD treatment providers for these codes was lower than the rate paid to mental health providers with the same credentials. This change will bring the SUD rates into alignment with the rates paid to mental health providers for the same codes.

What should you do?

CCOs: No action is required on your part. The OHA Actuarial Services Unit has determined that this change does not affect capitation rates. However, if OHA amends the capitation rates during the contract cycle, OHA will consider the SUD rate change and other small changes during the rate development process.

SUD providers: When billing with these codes and modifiers, please apply Oregon Administrative Rules and billing guidance, as with all Medicaid claiming. Correct coding and documentation of services provided must be on file to justify the claim.
