Subject: H0039 restricted to certified ACT providers beginning July 1, 2023

Effective July 1, 2023, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is restricting use of procedure code H0039 (Assertive Community Treatment, face-to-face, per 15 minutes) to qualified ACT providers as defined in Oregon Administrative Rule [309-019-0230](#) (ACT Provider Qualifications).

Why is this happening?

This change will help ensure that OHA only pays qualified providers for ACT services.

What should you do?

No action is required on your part. Please continue to bill as usual. Certified ACT providers should experience no disruption to reimbursement.
