Subject: Fee-for-service reprocessing for certain Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) claims starting March 3, 2023

Starting this month, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is reprocessing certain Medicaid claims with paid dates from **April 1, 2021**, through **March 31, 2022**, according to the following schedule:

Reprocessing Month(s)	For Claim Paid Dates:
March 2023	April 1 through June 30, 2021.
April-June 2023	July 1 through September 30, 2021.
July-September 2023	October 1 through December 31, 2021.
October-December 2023	January 1 through March 31, 2022.

For claims where this activity causes OHA to pay less than the original paid amount, OHA is paying the difference between the original and reprocessed claims.

For SBHS and TCM claims, this activity will cause OHA to return money to their local match account.

Why is this happening?

This will allow OHA to receive increased federal match for HCBS claims as authorized in the American Rescue Plan and ensure that providers do not lose money during this process. The increased federal match means the reprocessed SBHS and TCM claims will require less local match.

What should you do?
