Notice of intent – OHA proposes to amend the Medicaid State Plan to expand the number of providers eligible for hemophilia treatment reimbursement

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) intends to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to:

- Establish standards of care for treating hemophilia patients.
- Allow providers that meet the new standards of care to enroll as hemophilia treatment center.
- Reimburse Hemophilia Treatment Centers of Excellence at the 340B outpatient rate.
- Reimburse pharmacies at the outpatient drug rate in the current Medicaid State Plan.

Background:

OHA's single-source contract with the Oregon Health & Science University Hemophilia Center expired Dec. 31, 2022. If approved, this amendment will allow the Oregon Health Plan to reimburse for hemophilia treatment services based on provider type.
