Notice of intent – OHA will amend the Medicaid State Plan to remove an obsolete Targeted Case Management program

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will submit a State Plan Amendment to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to remove the Healthy Homes Asthma Targeted Case Management (TCM) program from Oregon's Medicaid State Plan.

### Background

In 2010 the Multnomah County Health Department partnered with OHA's Public Health Division to establish this program. The Healthy Homes Asthma TCM program was for clients with poorly controlled asthma or a history of environmentally induced respiratory distress in Multnomah County. This program no longer is in operation. Oregon Health Plan (OHP) members can still receive case management through other OHP programs currently in operation.
