CCOs that make use of this extension must include a revised version of the completed BH P&Ps evaluation criteria file with their IIBHT P&Ps, updated for the required components applicable to IIBHT. Evaluation of IIBHT P&Ps will begin after the new 4/25/2022 due date.
