### Notice of intent — OHA will amend the Medicaid State Plan to expand the Nurse Home Visiting program to two more counties.

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The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to expand the Family Connects Nurse Home Visiting program into Lane County effective Nov. 1, 2024, and Polk County effective Jan. 1, 2025. The program provides Targeted Case Management services to Medicaid-eligible infants from birth through 6 months of age.

- The annual Federal Fund estimate for Lane County is \$128,227.
- The annual Federal Fund estimate for Polk County is \$22,636.

Target Group:

Targeted case management (TCM) services will be provided to Medicaid eligible infants 0 through 6 months of age.

For case management services provided to individuals in medical institutions:

Target group comprised of individuals transitioning to a community setting and case management services will be made available for up to 180 consecutive days of the covered stay in the medical institution.
