**Subject:** Changes to State Match for Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) Program

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The Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) program is a leveraged program. House Bill 4105 (2024) provided Oregon Health Authority (OHA) one-time funding to cover the state match for NFP claims. This funding ended June 28, 2025, and OHA can no longer provide the state match share.

OHA is updating the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) to reflect this change.

### What does this mean?

All claims submitted on or after June 28, 2025, will suspend until OHA receives state match payments for the claims. OHA cannot accept state match payments until MMIS updates are complete. OHA will let you know when this happens.

### What you should do:

OHA will notify you once the system update is complete. To receive payments for claim submitted on or after June 28, 2025, please submit state match payments once OHA completes necessary system updates. Continue to use the Provider Type NFP (64/518) for NFP.
