**Subject:** Next steps for processing suspended NFP claims

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Oregon Health Authority (OHA) has completed Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) changes to resume processing Oregon NFP Targeted Case Management (TCM) claims through the state's leveraged program system. See previous [memo](#) from July 9, 2025.

- MMIS now indicates NFP provider accounts with Provider Type 64 and Provider Specialty 518 are leveraged programs.
- On Friday, Nov. 14, 2025, OHA released claims for services rendered from July 1, 2025 onward for processing. MMIS will issue payments only for NFP TCM claims with state match funds in the program's leverage account.
- Moving forward, MMIS will process all submitted NFP TCM claims to account for the non-federal share, ensuring full payment is issued once local match funds are available.
- Claims and adjustments for services dated prior to July 1, 2025, will remain on hold pending further configuration. We will provide an update when this process is completed.

### What you should do:

- Please submit funds to the leverage account associated with your Medicaid ID for NFP TCM claims.

- Submit NFP TCM claims using the NFP Medicaid Provider ID, Type and Specialty for leveraged programs (Type 64, Specialty 518).
