Subject: Fee-for-service reprocessing of neonatal and pediatric intensive care service professional claims

planned for week of September 12, 2022

Next week, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will reprocess all professional services claims paid from **January 1, 2022**, through **August 30, 2022**. You will see this activity on outgoing remittance advices starting Tuesday, September 13, 2022.

Why is this happening?

On August 31, 2022, OHA updated pricing to <u>apply an Oregon-specific conversion factor to increase the fee-for-service rates for procedure codes 99468 through 99480</u>. The reprocessing will apply the updated pricing to claims paid during the timeframe listed above.

What should you do?

No action is required on your part.

What you will see on the paper remittance advice

The Claims Paid section will list the affected claims with a Detail EOB code of 9920: Pricing Adjustment – RBRVS Pricing Applied.

What you will see on the electronic remittance advice (ERA) or Provider Web Portal

Both the ERA and Provider Web Portal will list *Adjustment Reason Code 45: Charge exceeds fee schedule/maximum allowable or contracted/legislated fee arrangement.* Again, no action is required on your part.
