Subject: Resolving conflicts between OARs 410-130-0700 and 410-130-0220

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) has determined that Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) [410-130-0700](#) and [410-130-0220](#) contain conflicting requirements. These rules apply to the fee-for-service (FFS) program's payments for medical surgical professional services. They conflict in the details for which procedure codes are bundled and are not paid separately. CCOs are required to follow these rules when paying non-participating providers and may have chosen to align their policies for other payments with these rules. OHA is updating the rules to resolve this conflict. In the interim, where the rules conflict, CCOs should follow 410-130-0220.

Why is this happening?

OHA is revising these rules and directing CCOs to follow 410-130-0220 in order to provide clear direction for CCOs and consistency across the Oregon Health Plan system.

What should you do?

- When OARs 410-130-0700 and 410-130-0220 are in conflict, apply the requirements of 410-130-0220.
- Refer to the temporary rule filing for [410-130-0700](#) on the [Chapter 410 Temporary Rule Filings](#) page. The temporary rule is effective 1/20/2026 through 7/18/2026.
- Contribute comments and/or join our rules advisory committee to help draft the revised rule.
