On August 13, 2021, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) updated the Medicaid fee-for-service rates for private duty nursing services effective July 1, 2021. These rates are for private duty nursing services administered by OHA and the Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS).

OHA Private Duty Nursing services: Approved and paid as an hourly rate.
