Notice of intent – OHA will amend the Medicaid State Plan to increase fee-for-service primary care rates.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) approval of the 2022-2027 Oregon Health Plan (OHP) 1115 Demonstration waiver requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to reimburse primary care providers an expected minimum amount. To comply with these minimums, OHA plans to amend the Medicaid State Plan to increase the rates for primary care services by an additional two percent.

The current conversion factor is \$27.82 and will increase to \$28.50. The increase applies to:

- Most evaluation and management codes,
• Immunization administration codes, and
• Health and behavior assessment/intervention codes.
