Subject: Substance Use Disorder Assessment Codes: Fee Schedule Update

As of May 5, 2025, the Behavioral Health Fee Schedule Substance Use Disorder Service tab has been updated to correct the rate being paid for the following codes:

Code	Description	Rate	Unit	Required Modifiers ¹	Allowed Modifiers	Rendering Provider Types ²
Q9991	Injection, buprenorphine extended-release (sublocade), less than or equal to 100 mg	\$1,931.81	PER SERVICE			Certified SUD Program
Q9992	Injection, buprenorphine extended-release (sublocade), greater than 100 mg	\$1,931.81	PER SERVICE			Certified SUD Program

Q9991 and Q9992 were previously listed in the fee schedule as being paid at the rate of \$1,825.83. This rate was increased to \$1,931.81 effective Jan. 1, 2025 and now aligns with rates posted in the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS).

What should you do?

Continue billing for services using these codes. They will continue to be paid at the updated rate, effective Jan. 1, 2025.
