Subject: New due date for pre-release Reentry services readiness plan

This communication is to notify CCOs about the due date extension for the Contract Year (CY) [2026](#) deliverable listed below.

- **Ex. B, Pt. 2, Sec. 18, Para. c:** Readiness plan for pre-release Reentry health care services.
- **Original due date:** Prior to January 1, 2027
- **New due date:** January 31, 2027

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will provide CCOs with the readiness plan template no later than November 2, 2026.

Why is this happening?

OHA decided to extend the due date in anticipation of a slower roll-out for *pre-release* Reentry services in CY 2027. This is informed by the experience from the roll-out for *post-release* Reentry services in CY 2026. Some CCOs have yet to serve any members eligible for *post-release* Reentry services; OHA expects comparable low demand for *pre-release* services. The later due date is intended to

balance the need for CCOs to be ready to provide *pre-release* services with the expected low demand for services.

What should you do?

Submit your CCO's pre-release Reentry health care services readiness plan by the new due date.
