Notice of intent — OHA will amend the Medicaid State Plan to attest compliance with mandatory quality measure reporting.

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to update the Medicaid State Plan. The update will add assurances that Oregon will meet CMS's reporting requirements for the [Child and Adult Core Sets quality measures](#).

Background

CMS requires states to submit this SPA to attest compliance with the mandatory reporting requirements for the Child Core Set and the behavioral health measures on the Adult Core Set reporting outlined in 42 CFR 431.16 and 437.10 through 437.15. Oregon has been reporting these core measures for several years but the reports will become mandatory for state reporting December 1, 2024.

Fiscal impact:

There is no additional fiscal impact to make this change.

A.1. The agency assures that all requirements of 42 CFR 431.16 are met.

a. All measures on the Child Core Set that are identified by the Secretary pursuant to 42 CFR 437.10.

b. All behavioral health measures on the Adult Core Set that are identified by the secretary pursuant to 42 CFR 437.10.
