**Subject:** Substance Use Disorder Behavioral Health Fee Schedule Update: S0109 Methadone Addition

The Behavioral Health Fee Schedule Substance Use Disorder Service tab has been updated to **add** the below billing code to line 63:

Code	Description	Price	Unit
S0109	Methadone, 5mg	\$0.18	Per Dose

A new billing code is now available for 5mg doses of methadone. Eligible SUD providers can use this code for medication reimbursement. This code can be used to bill for methadone dispensed on-site and for take-home doses.

There are no bundled codes that already include reimbursement for methadone medication. This code is for the methadone medication only, meaning you should continue to bill for medication administration and other services, in addition to billing this code. The use of this code for the methadone medication will assist in tracking distribution.

The effective date for this new billing code is 7/1/2025. It is eligible to be applied to all services rendered on or after that date.
