**Subject:** Changes to daily limits for fee-for-service SUD treatment codes, effective January 1,2019.

Starting January 1,2019, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will reimburse the following codes as listed below:

Code	Description	Units	Limit
H0005	Group counseling by a clinician	Per service	2 per day
H0006	Case management	Per service	2 per day
H0015	Intensive outpatient treatment (program that operates at least 3 hours/day and at least 3 days/week and is based on an individualized treatment plan)	Per service	1 per day

OHA has updated its claim system with these changes to the units and daily limits.

### Why is this happening?

For these codes, the [National Correct Coding Initiative](#) limits the number of services provider can render per day.

### What should you do?

When billing these codes for services provided, use the program modifiers listed below.

- HF: Substance use disorder
- HG: Opioid use disorder
