Subject: Behavioral Health Fee Schedule rate adjustments effective April 1, 2026

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) has adjusted the following rates effective April 1, 2026, as mandated by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services. OHA will publish the updated rates in the July 1, 2026 Behavioral Health Fee Schedule.
