Subject: Changes to CY 2024 annual status reports for Statewide Performance Improvement Projects (PIPs)

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision affecting the following requirement in the Contract Year (CY) [2024](#) coordinated care organization (CCO) contracts:

- Exhibit B, Part 10, Section 6, Paragraph e: This paragraph describes the requirement for the CCO to submit annual status reports for the two Statewide PIPs. The due dates for these reports are January 31, 2025, for January-December 2024 activities.

The two Statewide PIPs for CY 2024 are (i) mental health access monitoring and (ii) initiation and engagement of Substance Use Disorder treatment (SUD IET). OHA is making the following changes to the CY 2024 annual status report for each PIP:

Mental Health Access Monitoring PIP

OHA hereby **waives** the CY 2024 requirement to submit the annual status report for the mental health access monitoring PIP. This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirement relating to this PIP in the CY 2024 CCO contract.

SUD IET PIP

The due date for the annual progress report for the SUD IET PIP is extended to **April 30, 2025**. OHA made this change to better align progress reporting with the availability of CY 2024 data and preparations for annual PIP validation reporting.

These changes do not alter the requirement for CCOs to submit information about both PIPs by July 31, 2025, for External Quality Review validation purposes. The instructions and template for this submission will be provided on the CCO Contract Forms [webpage](#) at least 90 days before the due date.
