Notice of intent – OHA will amend the Medicaid State Plan to revise the effective date of its contract with Sweep Optical.

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) intends to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services. The SPA will amend the Medicaid State Plan to revise the effective date and rate of OHA's contract with Sweep Optical.

The estimated Total Fund cost for the new contract is \$93,010 for 12 months. This includes the increase labor costs, delivery costs and tariff surcharges for lens, frames and raw materials.

Background

Oregon law (ORS 279.835) requires public agencies like OHA to contract with Qualified Rehabilitation Facilities (QRFs) for products and services when available and suitable. The new effective date aligns with the new contract amendment for payments to Sweep Optical, the QRF that provides eyeglasses, contacts and hardware for fee-for-service Oregon Health Plan members.
