**Subject:** Annual TQS Progress Report

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision to waive the following requirement in the Contract Year (CY) 2021 coordinated care organization (CCO) contracts:

- Exhibit B, Part 10, Section 2: Paragraph d. describes the requirement for the CCO to submit an annual TQS Progress Report by September 30 of each Contract Year. The TQS Progress Report is a mid-year progress report to ensure the CCO is moving forward with implementing its TQS.

**OHA hereby waives the requirement to submit the annual TQS Progress Report as set forth in the contract section cited above for CY 2021.** This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirement relating to Transformation and Quality Strategy Requirements as described in the CCO contract. The TQS Progress Report requirement will be removed from the CY 2022 contract.
