Subject: Public posting of TQS Section III

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision to waive the following requirement in its coordinated care organization (CCO) 2.0 contracts effective October 1, 2019:

- **Exhibit B, Part 10, Section 2, Transformation and Quality Strategy Requirements:** Paragraph a. of this section describes the requirement for CCOs to create an annual Transformation and Quality Strategy (TQS). The TQS is subject to review and approval by OHA. Paragraph b. prescribes the use of a template provided by OHA for each CCO's TQS. The current TQS template is comprised of the following sections: Section 1: Transformation and Quality Program Information; Section 2: Transformation and Quality Program Details; and Section 3: Required Transformation and Quality Program Attachments.
- **Exhibit D, Section 14, Transparency: Public Posting of Contractor Reports:** Paragraph a. of this section describes the requirement for OHA to publicly post all CCO Reports identified in Exhibit D – Attachment 1 as subject to public posting, with approved redactions. The TQS is identified as a Report subject to public posting and redaction.

OHA hereby waives the requirement to publicly post Section III of each CCO's TQS approved by OHA for Contract Year 2020. This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirement relating to the TQS as described in the CCO 2.0 contract.
